ASSAM & NAGALAND

13 NIGHTS / 14 DAYS

This itinerary is to explore and experience the culture of the people of Nagaland. This is a tribal tour itinerary and only guests interested in such a tour should be encouraged. Infrastructure development in the sector is very basic. Accommodation, food and other facilities are very basic with local flavor. Accommodation will be in local cottages, tourist lodges and guest houses and not in hotels at par with developed sector.

DAY 1 DIMAPUR

Welcome on arrival in Dimapur Airport / Railway station. Transfer to Hotel. Dimapur is known as the hub of Nagaland. Later explore the city market, the Kachari ruins kindom which is only a couple of kilometre from the town. Meet the local craftsmen and witness the Nagaland Bamboo Development Agency which is situated 6km from the town where you will see items made from bamboo. Overnight in Dimapur.

DAY 2 DIMAPUR – BENREU VILLAGE 120KM / 5HRS

Today drive to Benrue village of the Zeliang Naga, known for their beautiful attires and dances. After lunch explore the village where you will see the *morung* – the informal institution where the oral tradition, history are passed from one generation to another which is always attached with a male dormitory. Meet the local people see the local way of life and their house decorated with the animal skulls. Overnight in Benrue Community cottage.

DAY 3 BENREU - KHONOMA 45Kms / 2½ hrs.

Today proceed on to Khonoma. The 2 ½ hrs drive, winding road with hairpin bends and scenic landscape is very pleasant sight. Enroute one can stop over at Dzulekie village where one can go for traditional fishing and enjoy the nature as the village itself is in the midst of the jungle we can also see the majestic State animal *Mithum*. Enjoy picnic lunch. The next stop is Khonoma the first "Green Village" of the country. Overnight in Khonoma Home saty.

DAY 4 KHONOMA

Afetr breakfast take a tour of the green village visiting the Morungs, meeting the local craftsmen. Visit the age group house & the ceremonial gates. Collectively Khonoma was known for its fighting prowess in the past and for the fallow management of its alder trees which balance the nature and its surrounding areas. Enjoy picnic lunch. Afternoon indigenous games will be displayed. Overnight in Khonoma Home Stay.

DAY 5 KHONOMA - KOHIMA. 20KM / 1Hr.

Today drive to Kohima, the state capital. Visit Cemetery, the Sale Emporium and local bazaar where one can be introduced to the Naga food items consisting of vegetables, insects and fishes. Post lunch visit Jakhama village experience the real Angami Naga tribal way of living. Also visit the Heritage Complex where the Hornbill festival is celebrated every year from the 1st of December to 7th of December. Overnight in Kohima Hotel.

DAY 6 KOHIMA - TUOPHEMA. 42 Kms / 1½ hrs

The next morning visit Kohima village the 2nd largest village in Asia and be a witness of the 2nd World War bullet marks on the wall. Next visit the State Museum where one will come across a good representation of Naga attires and way of life. Lunch at Tuophema. Post lunch walk around the village and head back to the lodge for an evening cultural program. Overnight in Tuophema. Community cottages.

DAY 7 TUOPHEMA - MOKOKCHUNG 120KM / 5 HRS.

With packed lunch drive to Mokokchung- the headquarter of the Ao Nagas. They are known for their colourful attires and are regarded of having the most motifs shawl among the Nagas, which usually speaks the person's status in the community.

En route get introduce to a Rengma Naga village TSEMINYU one can also collect their souvenir as we will see fantastic local weavers in this village.

Picnic lunch. Drive to Longkhum village (Ao village) which was known as the vanguard of the Ao region during the spear and dao era. As the village is situated at 1586 mt. above sea level we can see some part of Himalaya on a clear winter morning. Depending on the time of arrival, explore Mopunchket village bamboo forest. Overnight in Mokokchung Hotel.

DAY 8 MOKOKCHUNG - LONGLENG 45KM / 2½ hrs.

Today drive to Longleng the home town of the PHOM Nagas. We venture Mopunchket village where we will see the amazing wood carvings which shows the life-cycle and their bamboo forest. Visit Impur museum still the tolls used by the missionaries are keeping intact.. Depending on the time of arrival to Longleng we shall explore villages like pongo, Hukktong.

Overnight in Longleng Paying Guest/ Home stay.

DAY 9 LONGLENG - MON 160KM / 6½Hrs.

Today with packed lunch drive to Mon the homeland of the Konkay Nagas through a very thrilling road which narrow and some part the grass on both the sides of the roads sweeps the jeep as we drive. Konyak are known for their skill in making use of metal as they are the first among the Nagas who make *muzzle loading gun*. They are the only Naga who live under the control of an inheritant Angh, locally, meaning chief. Enroute visit wakching village see the massive wood carvings in front of the *morung*. Overnight in Mon Paying Guest.

DAY 10 MON – LONGWA – MON 42KM / 2 Hrs.

Visit Longwa village which directly borders with Myanmar. As a proof to this the International boundary line divides the Angh's/chief house. Explore the village meet the local people, if luck favours one will get to see tattooed people which directly shows that they are real man of those days, during headhunting days, see the massive wood carving in front of the Morung pillars on which motifs of tiger, elephant, hornbill, human beings etc.

On our way back, to Mon, visit Shangkhachingnyu village meet the local gun- smith, step in the Angh's house see the animal head trophies on the wall. Overnight in Mon Paying Guest.

DAY11 MON

After breakfast drive to Shangnyu village 28km 2hrs, here you will see the wooden monument measuring 8feet in height and 13feet in breath – believed to be constructed by the heavenly angles. Human being and other creatures are carved on this monument. One can also see the memorial stone erected in front of the Angh's house. Post lunch visit Chui village bear a witness of the true Konyak Naga traditional house where the main pillar of the house jutting out of the roof. Overnight in Mon. Paying Guest.

DAY12 MON - SIVASAGAR (ASSAM) 130KM / 5Hrs.

Today you experience a total shift from the hill to the plain- from the leisure of counting and greeting anybody you meet to a rat race traffic. That difference is Sivasagar once the Capital city of the Ahom Kingdom awaits you with all its history behind, may be, the warm greeting with its heat too. Lunch at

Sivasagar. Post lunch drive to Amguri visit a Mishing village, *option*, on Horse or walk in the afternoon Assam Cultural dance. Overnight in Sivasagar Hotel.

DAY 13 SIVASAGAR - DIBRUGARH 77KM / 2½ Hrs.

Morning visit the Ahom Palace and Temples Karenghar, Rang Ghar, which were constructed during the Ahoms' rule over Assam. Visit Shiva Temple etc. Afternoon transfer to Dibrugarh . Overnight in Dibrugarh.

DAY 14 DEPARTURE

Morning take a tour to witness tea gardens. In time transfer for onward journey.

ASSAM & ARUNACHAL

18 NIGHTS / 19 DAYS

DAY 1 DIBRIGARH

Welcome on arrival in Dibrugarh airport. Check into Tea Bunglow. Later visit tea gardens & tea factory.. Overnight in Dibrigarh.

DAY 2 DIBRIGARH - DIBRUSAIKHOWA NP - TINSUKIA

Early morning drive to Dibru Saikhowa National Park. Explore the park in the morning and afternoon.

Dibru Saikhowa National Park: Dibru – Saikhowa, the largest National Park of Assam, spread over an area of 650 sq. km is located about 13 kms from Tinsukia town. Surrounded by the Brahmaputra and Dibru rivers, it has several water bodies (beels), internal river channels, lush evergreen forests and grasslands. The government of Assam had merged two reserve forests namely- Dibru and Saikhowa in 1986 and declared it as a wildlife sanctuary. Later in 1999 it had got the status of National Park. Today it is renowned as one of the 19 (nineteen) biodiversity hotspots in the world and becoming a safe heaven for many rare and endangered species of wild life and avifauna. The Park is mainly famous for its initiatives to protect the White-winged wood duck in its natural habitat and the bright coloured wild horses

known as Feral Horses. The other rare and endangered animals comprises of Hoolock gibbon, capped langur, slow loris, gangetic river dolphin, Elephants etc.

The Park is a paradise for the bird watchers as it is the home of numbers of imperilled birds. Some of them are - Cotton Pygmy-goose, Spot-billed Pelicans, Drongo Cuckoo, Pale-capped Pigeon, Geyleg goose, Brahmini duck, Bar-headed goose, Pale-footed Bush Warbler, Japanese Bush Warbler, Babbler, Black-breasted Weaver, Black-faced Bunting etc.

The entry point to the park is from the Guijan jetty (10km from Tinsukia). The forest department provides the local made boat for the tourists to enter into the park.

Later drive to Tinsukia. Overnight in Tinsukia.

DAY 3 TINSUKIA - DEBAN

Morning after breakfast drive to Diban. En route visit Miao, the first camp of Namdapha National Park.

Diban: A beautiful forest camp on the bank of the river Noa-Dihing. It is located within the boundary of Namdapha National Park. One can enjoy the scenic beauty of overlooking Noa-Dihing river. The Forest Inspection Bungalow located at Deban itself surrounded by evergreen forest over looking the river Noa-Dihing is worth-staying. It is also ideal for trekking, hiking and angling on the river Noa-Dihing.

Arrive and check in at traditionally built Diban Guest House. Evening free to enjoy the scenic beauty of Diban.

DAY 4 DEBAN – NAMDAPHA FOREST CAMP

Morning after breakfast go for trekking inside the Namdapha National Park.

En route stop at:

Haldibari: This pictureque camping spot, just 5 Km away from Deban, lies across the Noa-Dehing river can be reached by boat. An overnight stay here is enjoyable experience in jungle camping.

Bulbulia: This is an enchanting camping site overlooking a large aquifer and derives its name from its several natural springs. You need to be extremely lucky for an opportunity to stay here overnight and experience close encounters with wild animals frequenting the water holes in the dark.

Camera Point: This camping site, as the name suggests offers a vantage point for a breath-taking view of Namdapha and its lush green landscape.

Afternoon reach at Hornbill camp.

During the course of trekking witness the several types of vegetations and birds: Among the bird species, most notable are the White winged Wood Ducks, a rare and endangered species, the great Indian hornbills, jungle fowls and pheasants flop their noisy way through the jungle, and which harbours other colourful bird and animal species. The inaccessibility of greater part of the park has helped to keep the forests in their pristine and virgin state in its natural form. Moreover, the park possesses great bio diversity of flora and fauna. The lush green under growths are thick and intertwined like cobwebs of canes, bamboos, wild bananas and variety of vegetations. The grandeur of the wet tropical rain forest is breeding ground for varieties of animals and birds which is remarkable and worth seeing.

Arrive and overnight at the forest camp.

DAY 5 NAMDAPHA - DEBAN

Morning after breakfast again start trekking to Diban Guest house. One can also enjoy the elephant safari instead of trekking during the whole stretch. Arrive Diban and check in at the Diban Guest House.

Overnight at Guest House.

DAY 6 DIBAN - DIBRUGARH – JORHAT (320 kms / 7 hrs)

Morning after breakfast drive to Jorhat via Dibrugarh. Enroute sightseeing of Sivasagar (65 KM). Sivasagar, the erstwhile capital of the Ahom Rulers, is a beautiful town located around the huge artificial lake -Sibsagar tank & the Shiva Temple. Overnight in Jorhat.

DAY 7 JORHAT – MAJULI - JORHAT

Morning after early breakfast drive to Nimati Ghat. Proceed to Majuli, world's largest river Island situated in the midst of river Brahmaputra. You will take a boat ride in an individually hired local boat to reach Majuli. Visit different Vaishnavite Satras with our guide taking you through the culture and history of the region. Transfer to Jorhat by local boat. Night halt in Jorhat.

DAY 8 JORHAT – KAZIRANGA

Morning after breakfast drive to Kaziranga Enroute visit Gibbon Wild Life Sanctuary. Overnight in Kaziranga.

DAY 9 KAZIRANGA

Kaziranga National Park - The World Heritage Site is the oldest park in Assam & is located on the banks of the Brahmaputra River. Kaziranga National Park is a natural habitat for conservation of biologically diverse flora & fauna. It is inhabited by the world's largest population of one-horned rhinoceroses besides sheltering about 15 species of India's threatened mammals. There are numerous other major wildlife fauna.

After breakfast visit tea garden & Assamese villages. Return to resort for lunch. After Lunch Jeep Safari to Western Range. Return & Free for Personal activities. Overnight in Kaziranga. Evening enjoy 'Bihu'; the folk dance of Assam, especially organized for you. Overnight in Kaziranga.

DAY 10 KAZIRANGA

After Breakfast enjoy Jeep safari to Central Range [Jeep Safari duration is Approx 2 ½ hours]. After breakfast visit Tea gardens. After Lunch Jeep Safari to Western Range. Overnight in Kaziranga.

DAY 11 KAZIRANGA – NAMERI

Morning after breakfast drive to Nameri. Overnight in Nameri Eco camp.

DAY 12 NAMERI

Nameri National Park - Located at the foothills of eastern Himalayas with the the river Jia Bhoroli flowing through it, the park is the second Tiger reserve of Assam. Many rare animals inhabit the park.

Morning take a walk at Nameri National Park. Enjoy one time rafting at Jia Bhoroli river. Day free for other leisure activities in Nameri (activities at additional expenses). Overnight in Nameri.

DAY 13 NAMERI - SONAPUR

Morning after breakfast drive to a Jungle resort in Sonapur. Enroute sightseeing in Tezpur town. Overnight in Resort

DAY 14 SONAPUR – POBITORA WILDLIFE SANCTUARY - SONAPUR

Early morning drive to Pobitora Wildlife Sanctuary. Enjoy Elephant Safari at the sanctuary (Safari charges additional). The Pobitora Wildlife Sanctuary is at distance of 50 km from Guwahati. The Pobitora Rhino breeding programme has been so successful that it has the highest concentration of one horned rhinos. Over 200 migratory birds are found here. Day free for leisure. Overnight in Resort.

DAY 15 SONAPUR – GUWAHATI

Morning drive to Guwahati. Later take afternoon Guwahati city tour including Srimanta Shankardev Kalakshetra, Guwahati Zoo, State museum & Emporiums for local ethnic products. Overnight in Guwahati..

DAY 16 GUWAHATI – MANAS NATIONAL PARK

Welcome on arrival at Guwahati Airport / Railway station. Drive to Manas (180 km / 4hrs). Lunch en route. Dinner and Overnight in Manas.

DAY 17 MANAS

Manas National Park - It is located in in the Himalayan foothills. The Manas river flows through the National Park which acts an international border diving India and Bhutan. The Park is Project Tigers, Rhinos & Elephant Reserve. Also visit Manas for its rare and endangered endemic wildlife such as the Assam Roofed Turtle, Hispid Hare, Golden Langur and Pygmy Hog.

Morning take a safari at Manas National Park. After breakfast take a half day jeep safari. Lunch, Dinner and overnight in resort..

DAY 18 MANAS - GUWAHATI

Morning after breakfast drive to Guwahati. Lunch in Guwahati. Rest free for shopping. Visit the Kalakshetra Cultural Complex. Evening take a river cruise at Brahmaputra river. Dinner and overnight in Guwahati.

DAY 19 DEPARTURE

Morning in time transfer to Guwahati Airport. Enroute take a darshan of Maa Kamakhya Temple.

DAY 1 GUWAHATI

Welcome on arrival at Guwahati Airport / Railway station. - In Guwahati visit Srimanta Shankardev Kalakshetra, Guwahati Zoo, State museum & Emporiums for local ethnic products. You may visit Balaji Temple or take a river cruise (cruise at additional charges).

DAY 2 GUWAHATI – NAMERI

Morning drive to Nameri Eco Camp. Nameri National Park - Located at the foothills of eastern Himalayas with the the river Jia Bhoroli flowing through it, the park is the second Tiger reserve of Assam. Many rare animals inhabit the park. Day free for leisure activities in Nameri like rafting. (activities at additional expenses).

DAY 3 NAMERI – TIPPI

Morning take a walk or Safari at Nameri National Park. Drive to Tippi & overnight stay

DAY 4 TIPPI - EAGLES NEST WILDLIFE SANCTUARY - TIPPI

Drive to Eagles Nest Wild Life Sanctuary - a sanctuary of 217.00 Sq. Kms. The sanctuary is home to various endangered species & a number of nonhuman primates like Slow Loris, Assamese macaque, Rhesus macaque, Capped Langur, three threatened bird species , five near threat ened species are also found. Return to Tippi & overnight stay.

DAY 5 TIPPI - BOMDILA

Morning drive to Bomdila. Visit the Tippi Orchid Research Centre with more than 500 species of orchids. Overnight in Bomdila.

DAY 6 BOMDILA

Morning visit the monastery & Bazaar in Bomdila. Day free at leisure. Overnight in Bomdila.

DAY 7 BOMDILA - TAWANG

Morning drive to Tawang. Enroute witness the snowcapped Sella Pass at 14000 ft and the Jaswant Garh War Memorial. (Legend has it that Jaswant (Mahavir Chakra Awardee (Posthumous) of 4th Battalion Garhwal Rifles), fought a lone battle against the invading Chinese during the 1962 war. His spirit is still believed to protect the place). Overnight in Tawang.

DAY 8 TAWANG

Tawang - The beautiful land of the Monpa tribes with the "GALDEN NAMGYEL LHATSE" Monestary - one of the largest Lamaseries of Mahayana sect in Asia. The birth place of the 6th Dalai Lama, the Monastery is 400 year old and is adorned with the 18 feet high statue of Lord Buddha. 'The Land of Dawn-lit Mountains' at 3500 mts gives you unparallel purity of nature. Visit the monastery and the War Memorial. Evening free for shopping. Overnight in Tawang.

DAY 9 TAWANG – CHINA BORDER - TAWANG

Day free. You may visit Madhuri Lake and China Border at additional cost. Overnight in Tawang.

DAY 10 TAWANG - DIRANG

Morning drive to Dirang. Evening free in Dirang. Overnight in Dirang.

DAY 11 DIRANG

Tour the unique Dirang Valley famous for its monasteries, hot Springs, Apple & kiwi Orchards, sheep breeding farms & charming valleys. Overnight in Dirang.

DAY 12 DIRANG - BHALUKPUNG

Morning after breakfast drive to Bhalukpung. Overnight in Bhalukpung.

DAY 13 BHALUKPUNG - ITANAGAR

Morning drive to Itanagar & overnight stay.

DAY 14 ITANAGAR

Enjoy full day sightseeing in Itanagar including Buddhist Temple, Ganga Lake & Jawaharlal Nehru Museum. Evening free for shopping. Overnight in Itanagar.

DAY 15 ITANAGAR - ZIRO

Morning drive to Ziro. Enroute visit tribal villages of Nishi tribe. Overnight in Ziro.

DAY 16 ZIRO

Morning full day Ziro Villages. Visit Apatani villages, Tarin fish farm, Emporium, Museum and local market. Drive to old Ziro Village. Overnight in Ziro.

DAY 17 ZIRO - DAPORIJO

Morning drive to Daporojo. Enroute visit Nishi as well as the Hill Miri Tribal villages like Raga, Tamin and Mori. Overnight in Daporojo.

DAY 18 DAPORIJO

Morning visit Shiva Cave and hike to Nayam Village. Visit the spentacular hanging rope bridge. Visit the Tagin Tribal Villages. Overnight in Daporojo.

DAY 19 DAPORIJO - ALONG

Morning drive to Along. Visit and witness the culture of the Adi tribe in various Adi villages. Afternoon visit museum & emporium. Overnight in Along. Overnight in Along.

DAY 20 ALONG - PASSIGHAT

Morning proceed to Passighat. Visit Museum and Cultural Centre. Evening free. Drive to Dr. Daying Ering Wildlife Sanctuary (20 km; safari / nature walk subject to availability & at additional expenses) famous for wild buffalo, tiger, sambar deer and wild duck & bounded by the Siang River. Overnight in Passighat.

DAY 21 PASSIGHAT - DIBRUGARH

Morning proceed to Dibrugarh by ferry. Enjoy tea garden and factory visit in the evening. Overnight in Dibrugarh. Overnight in Dibrugarh.

DAY 22 DIBRUGARH - TEZU

DAY 26 GUWAHATI - SUALKUCHI

Today visit Hajo (centre of various religions), Sualkuchi (the Silk village of Assam) & Madan Kamdev (the magnificent archaeological ruins.) .

Hajo - Hajo (28 km from Guwahati) is the centre for various religions - Hayagriva- Madhab Temple & Pao Mecca. Sualkuchi - 40 kms from Guwahati, 'The Silk Village' of Assam flaunts a weaving tradition which can be traced back to the 11th Century. known as the MANCHESTAR of the East. Sualkuchi produces the famous Muga, Pat and Eri silk, Endi material, Mekhela chadors & Gamosas made from this indigenous materials. Madan Kamdev - 'The Khajuraho of Assam', is one of the most important historical sites in Assam. The ruins of Madan Kamdev are believed to be the remains of more than 20 temples consigned to Lord Shiva belonging to the 10th to 12th century A.D. Wildlife parks are partially open & subject to weather condition

DAY 27 DEPARTURE

Morning take a Temple tour - Maa Kamakhya, Dol Govinda, Sukleshwar & Nabagraha Temple. In time transfer to airport / railway station for onward journey.

Collectively Khonoma was known for its fighting prowess in the past and for the fallow management of its alder trees which balance the nature and its surrounding areas. Enjoy picnic lunch. Afternoon indigenous games will be displayed. Overnight in Khonoma Home Stay.

DAY 11 KOHIMA – JAKHAMA VILLAGE - KOHIMA

Morning visit the local bazaar where one can be introduced to the Naga food items consisting of vegetables, insects and fishes. Later visit Jakhama village experience the real Angami Naga tribal way of living. Also visit the Heritage Complex where the Hornbill festival is celebrated every year from the 1st of December to 7th of December. Overnight in Kohima Hotel.

DAY 12 KOHIMA – IMPHAL

Morning drive to Imphal. Evening free at leisure. Overnight in Imphal.

DAY 13 IMPHAL

Today we take you for a cultural tour of the city covering monuments, temples and ceremonial places highlighting Imphal's rich past. Visit the Govindajee Temple, the War Cemeteries and the Khwairamband Bazaar. Overnight in Imphal.

DAY 14 IMPHAL – KEIBUL LAMJAO NATIONAL PARK - IMPHAL

Visit the Keibul Lamjao National Park (the only floating park in the world). It is the last natural habitat of the marsh dwelling brow-antlered deer locally called 'Sangai'. Take a half day city tour of Shillong.

The city's own **Ward's Lake** is popular for short garden walks & boating. The **Botanical Garden** offers plethora of indigenous and exotic plants & rare collection of orchids. **Butterfly Museum** is a storehouse of finest and rarest species of butterflies and moths. **Lady Hydari Park** is a Japanese style landscaped park endowed with stretches of roses & exquisite flowers. Morning drive to Shillong. Enroute Mawlynong, the cleanest village in Asia. With over 80 households, the village gives the ambiance of walking in a well maintained park ! Overnight in Shillong.

DAY 29 SHILLONG - GUWAHATI

DAY 7: BOMDILA – BHALUKPUNG

Morning drive to Bhalukpung. Evening free. Overnight in Bhalukpung.

DAY 8 BHALUKPUNG - ITANAGAR

Morning drive to Itanagar. Overnight stay in Itanagar.

DAY 9 ITANAGAR - ZIRO

Enjoy full day s/s in Itanagar including Buddhist Temple, Ganga Lake & Jawaharlal Nehru Museum. Evening free for shopping. Drive to Ziro & O/N.

DAY 10 ZIRO - DAPORIJO

Morning full day Ziro Villages. Visit Apatani villages, Tarin fish farm, Emporium, Museum and local market. Later drive to Daporojo. Enroute visit Nishi as well as the Hill Miri Tribal villages like Raga, Tamin and Mori. Overnight in Daporiyo.

DAY 11 DAPORIJO - ALONG

Morning visit Shiva Cave and hike to Nayam Village. Visit the spectacular hanging rope bridge. Visit the Tagin Tribal Villages. Drive to Along & O/N.

DAY 12 ALONG - PASSIGHAT

Visit and witness the culture of the Adi tribe in various Adi villages. Afternoon visit museum & emporium. Proceed to Passighat s/s & O/N.

DAY 13 PASSIGHAT – DIBRUGARH

DAY 14 DIBRUGARH - KAZIRANGA

Morning drive to Kaziranga. Enroute visit Sivasagar town. Overnight stay in Kaziranga.

DAY 15 KAZIRANGA – KOHIMA

Early morning enjoy Elephant Safari at Kaziranga National Park. Afternoon enjoy Jeep Safari at Kaziranga National Park (safari charges additional). Drive to Kohima. Proceed to Touphema Village Resort (40 km) run by the local Angami. O/N at the resort.

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DAY 22 IMPHAL – SILCHAR (265 km / 7-8 hrs)

Morning drive to Silchar. Overnight in Silchar.

DAY 23 SILCHAR – AIZAWL (200 km / 4 hrs)

Morning drive to Aizawl, the capital city of Mizoram. Evening enjoy local dance. Overnight in Aizawl.

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After breakfast take a tour of Aizawl visiting Durtlang Hills, Museum to see the glimpses of Mizo culture and Mini Zoological Garden. Drive to Falklawn Mizo Village (18 km) and later to Bung, a popular picnic spot. Evening is kept free for a shopping tour at Luangmual Handicraft Centre. Overnight in Aizawl.

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Overnight in Shillong.

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Witness the gorgeous Seven Sisters falls & visit the Mawsmai cave & Thangkharang Park. Overnight in Cherrapunjee.

Morning drive to Guwahati. Enroute visit Borapani Lake. Umiam Lake or Barapani - is the biggest artificial lake in Meghalaya. It offers an incredible experience of sailing, water skiing, water scooter & other water sports activities in midst of sylvan hills adorned by Khasi pines & peerless beauty. Enjoy water activities in Barapani lake (activities at additional expenses). Overnight in Guwahati.

DAY 37 GUWAHATI

Today take a Temple tour - Maa Kamakhya, Sukleshwar & Nabagraha Temple. Later take afternoon Guwahati city tour including Srimanta Shankardev Kalakshetra, Guwahati Zoo, State museum & Emporiums for local ethnic products. You may visit Balaji Temple or take a river cruise in the evening. Overnight in Guwahati..

Day 38 DEPARTURE

In time transfer to airport for onward journey.

DAY 1 GUWAHATI

Welcome on arrival at Guwahati Airport. Evening free for leisure. You may visit Balaji Temple or take a river cruise in the evening. Overnight in Guwahati.

DAY 2 GUWAHATI – CHERRAPUNJEE – SHILLONG

After early breakfast proceed to Cherrapunjee - The wettest place on Earth. Enjoy a pleasant drive to see water falls & gorges. Witness the gorgeous Seven Sisters falls & visit the Mawmai cave & Thangkharang Park. Return to Shillong. Enroute visit at Shillong Peak. Overnight in Shillong.

DAY 3 SHILLONG – DAWKI – MAWLYNONG – SHILLONG

After breakfast, proceed for a full day trip to Mawlynong, the cleanest village in Asia. With over 80 households, the village gives the ambiance of walking in a well maintained park ! A day in this village gives a insight into the life of the Khasis. Proceed to Dawki. En route you get to see excellent view of the faraway plains of Bangladesh. Return to Shillong. Overnight in Shillong.

DAY 4 SHILLONG – NAMERI (340 km / 7 -8 hrs)

Morning after breakfast drive to Nameri. Enroute cross the Koliabhomora bridge in Tezpur. Overnight in Nameri.

DAY 5 NAMERI – DIRANG (200 km / 7 hours)

Nameri National Park - Located at the foothills of eastern Himalayas with the the river Jia Bhoroli flowing through it, the park is the second Tiger reserve of Assam. Many rare animals inhabit the park. Morning take a walk at Nameri National Park. Later drive to Dirang. Overnight in Dirang.

DAY 6 DIRANG – TAWANG (140 km / 6 hours)

After breakfast drive to Tawang. Enroute witness the snowcapped Sella Pass at 14000 ft and the Jaswant Garh War Memorial. (Legend has it that Jaswant (Mahavir Chakra Awardee (Posthumous) of 4th Bataillion Garhwal Rifles), fought a lone battle against the invading Chinese during the 1962 war. His spirit is still believed to protect the place). Overnight in Tawang.

DAY 7 TAWANG

Tawang - The beautiful land of the Monpa tribes with the “GALDEN NAMGYEL LHATSE” Monestary - one of the largest Lamaseries of Mahayana sect in Asia. The birth place of the 6th Dalai Lama, the Monastery is 400 year old and is adorned with the 18 feet high statue of Lord Buddha. ‘The Land of Dawn-lit Mountains’ at 3500 mts gives you unparallel purity of nature.

Early morning visit the Tawang Monastery. Proceed to China Border & Madhuri Lake. Bum-La pass near Indo-China border is 16500 feet above sea level. Return to Tawang. Evening free for shopping. Overnight in Tawang.

DAY 8 TAWANG – BOMDILA (180 km / 6 hours)

After breakfast proceed to Bomdila. En route tour the unique Dirang Valley famous for its monasteries, hot Springs, Apple & kiwi Orchards, sheep breeding farms & charming valleys. Overnight in Bomdila.

DAY 9 BOMDILA – ITANAGAR (250 km / 5 hours)

Morning after breakfast drive to Itanagar. Evening at leisure. Overnight in Itanagar.

DAY 10 ITANAGAR – ZIRO (120 km / 4 hours)

Morning enjoy sightseeing in Itanagar including Buddhist Temple, Ganga Lake & Jawaharlal Nehru Museum. Later drive to Ziro. Overnight in Ziro.

DAY 11 ZIRO

Morning after breakfast take a full day visit to Ziro Villages. Visit Apatani villages, Tarin fish farm, Emporium, Museum and local market. Evening free at leisure. Overnight in Ziro.

DAY 12 ZIRO – DAPORIJO (170 km / 5 hours)

Morning after breakfast drive to Daporojo. Enroute visit Nishi as well as the Hill Miri Tribal villages like Raga, Tamin and Mori. Overnight in Daporijo.

DAY 13 DAPORIJO – ALONG (150 km / 5 hours)

Morning visit Shiva Cave and Nayam Village. Visit the spectacular hanging rope bridge. Visit the Tagin Tribal Villages. Later drive to Along. Overnight in Along.

DAY 14 ALONG

Morning after breakfast visit and witness the culture of the Adi tribe in various Adi villages. Afternoon visit museum & emporium. Overnight in Along.

DAY 15 ALONG – PASIGHAT (100 km / 4 hours)

Morning after breakfast drive to Pasighat. Overnight in Pasighat.

DAY 16 PASIGHAT – DIBRUGARH - JORHAT (6 hrs by ferry ; 150 km by road)

Morning after breakfast proceed to Dibrugarh by crossing the river Brahmaputra in a local ferry. On arrival, transfer to Jorhat. Overnight in Jorhat.

DAY 17 JORHAT – MAJULI (20 km by road; 3 hrs by ferry)

Early morning proceed to Majuli, world's largest river Island situated in the midst of river Brahmaputra. You will take a local ferry ride to reach Majuli. Visit different Vaishnavite Satras with our guide taking you through the culture and history of the region. Overnight in Majuli

DAY 18 MAJULI

Full day witness the various satras in Majuli. Overnight in Majuli.

DAY 19 MAJULI - DIBRUGARH

Transfer to Jorhat by local boat across the River Brahmaputra. Proceed to Dibrugarh. Overnight in Dibrugarh.

DAY 20 DIBRUGARH – ROING (195 kms, 5 hrs drive with 1 ½ hrs ferry ride in Brahmaputra)

Morning after breakfast drive to the Dhala Ghat to take the country made ferry to cross the Brahmaputra river. Later drive to Roing. Arrive and check in at the traditional guest house. Overnight at guest house. Roing: Roing is a census town in Lower Dibang Valley district in the Indian state of Arunachal Pradesh. The only town under Idu Mishmi dominated areas, has Mehao wild life sanctuary, Sally lake, Mehao lake and Mayudia mountain pass that remains covered with snow during peak winter. The town, located at the foothill of the Mishmi Hill is lively with friendly people.

DAY 21 ROING- MAYODIYA - ROING (57 kms, 2 hrs drive)

Morning after breakfast visit Mayodia, a unique hill resot situated at an altitude of 7000feet. It is named after Maya, a Nepali girl who missing in the snow and could not be traced out. It is an ideal trekking destination and paradise for bird watcher as many endangered specis are recorded including Trogoan. The scenic beauty of the snow clapped Miodia during winter is eye-catching. Later return to Roing.

Afternoon visit a Idu Mishmi village. The Idu Mishmi is a major sub-tribe of Mishmi group. Their brethren tribes are namely the DIGARU-MISHMI (TARAONS) and the MIJU-MISHMI (KAMANS).

The Idu Mishmi is one of the two major tribes of the area. The Idu Mishmis can be distinctively identified among other tribal groups of Arunachal Pradesh by their typical hairstyle, distinctive costumes and artistic patterns embedded on their clothes. Mythological characters like SINE-RU a first IGU (Idu Priest) still holds high place and reverence in the minds of the people. The prints of his palm on the huge rocks at Athu Popu near Keyala Pass in Dibang Valley district on China border, is supreme and holy shrine.

Overnight at guest house in Roing.

DAY 22 ROING – TEZU (110 kms, 4 hrs drive)

Morning after breakfast depart for Tezu - a small town and the headquarters of Lohit district of Arunachal Pradesh. The ancient inhabitant of this beautiful land of valley and rivers are the Mishmi tribes. This tribe still has a King and Queens residing in the district headquarters of Tezu. The Mishmi tribes have a rich tradition and customs dating back to the times of Mahabharata. It is said that Rukmini of Mahabharata was a Mishmi Damsel.

Arrive and check in at the tourist lodge (Basic accommodation). Afternoon visit a Mishmi tribal village.

The Mishmi an ethnic tribe comprising of mainly three tribes: Idu Mishmi; Digaru (Taraon) Mishmi, and Miju (Kaman) Mishmi. The Mishmis occupy the north-eastern tip of the central Arunachal Pradesh in Upper and Lower Dibang Valley, Lohit and Anjaw Districts. The three sub-divisions of the tribe emerged due to the geographical distribution, racially all these three sub tribes are of same origin but there are unnoticeable difference among these sub-tribes, i.e. of ORIGIN and DIALECT.

Overnight at tourist lodge in Tezu.

DAY 23 TEZU – CHONGKHAM – DIBRUGARH (230 kms, 6 hrs drive)

Morning after breakfast depart for Dibrugarh. En route visit Parasuram Kunda Chongkham.

Parasuram Kunda, a place of pilgrimage is situated in the bank of the river Lohit at about 24 Kms from Tezu. It is also known as 'Prabhu Kuthar', the origin of the 'Kunda' viz. Parasuram Kunda is associated with Parasuram's matricide. The history goes in brief that one day Renuka, mother of Parasuram went to Ganga for having bath and bringing water. But delay in bringing water made the Rishi Jamadagni, the husband of Renuka very angry as it was already getting late for the mid day worship. He asked the sons to kill her. None of his six sons except Parasuram could oblige. Parasuram chopped off the head of his mother in deference to the wishes of his father, but as a result of crime he was struck to his hand. Jamadagni was very pleased with him for carrying out his order and asked Parasuram to have boon. Parasuram prayed for bringing his mother back to life, then enquired as to how to get rid of the crime of matricide. Jamadagni granted it and his mother got her life back and told Parasuram to visit "Brahma Kund" to wash off the sin. Parasuram came to the Brahma Kund, in Lohit District of Arunachal Pradesh for holy dip in the kunda.

Chongkham: There are several Buddha-Vihar locally called CHONG in the Khamtis area. The world Peace Pagoda located in a river island at Chongkham is ideal for meditation in front of Buddha statues that surrounds in inner core of the vihar. The Khamti Raja's Chong at Guna Nagar at Chongkham is famous for relics of Gautama Buddha. All the CHONGs and statues of Lord Buddha are made in the Thai-architectural style. There is no ban to visit these CHONGs. On the way you can visit another Khampti village. The Khamptis are traditionally owners of elephants, with which they work in the forests. They cut trees and the elephants pull them out of the forest.

Overnight in Dibrugarh.

DAY 24 DIBRUGARH – SIVASAGAR – MON (210 Kms, 5 hrs drive with stop)

Morning after breakfast depart for Mon. En route stop at Moran for lunch.

Arrive at Mon and check in at hotel. Overnight at hotel in Mon.

Mon: Situated at an altitude of 897.64 meters it is the land of the Konyaks (One of the fiercest tribes in the world). Even though there is a legal administrative system, but actually it is ruled by tribal chiefs called Anghs (locally known as 'Wang' meaning the beginning of everything). Mon is the only district in Nagaland to have this unique institution of Anghship. The word of his is law in these parts. His succession is hereditary in nature. The Konyaks believe that they were direct descendants of Noah, for they have Biblical names like Mosa, Kaisa, Aron and so on. The konyaks are famous for their tattooed faces, blackened teeth and barbaric practice of Headhunting

DAY 25 MON – CHUI – LONGWA – MON

Early morning drive to Chui village, located about 8 kms away from Mon town on the Tuensang – Mon road Chui village still preserves its old charm. One can see the Konyak traditional houses built with palm leaves roofing with protruding out the main pillars. Chui is also famous for ethnic craftsmanship. The skill of the villagers is not confined only on bamboo and woodworks but they are prowess in gun and gunpowder making.

Later return to Mon and after having breakfast full day excursion for Longwa, which is 42 Kms from Mon. (3 hrs drive). En route stop at the bank of river Tapi / Taphi and have the packed lunch.

Longwa regarded as one of the biggest villages in Mon the unique feature of Longwa is it shares the international boundary of Myanmar and India (Half of the chief Angh's house falls in the Indian side and the other half falls in Myanmar). The Angh takes his food in India and sleeps in Myanmar's territory.

Mon village which is 7 Kms from Mon town. In the village you can meet the King. He ruled 12 villages – Tanhai, Pongkonmg, Longkei, Leangnyu, Hongphoi, L/Shanghah, Phuktong, Oting, Tumei, Lapa, Upper Tiru and Lower Tiru. Also visit the Morung where the village youths are being taught about the way of manly hood. Later pay a visit to a Konyak house to witness the traditional culture. Overnight at hotel in Mon.

DAY 26 MON – MUKUKCHONG (via Mariani) (200 Kms / 6 hours)

Morning after breakfast visit the Tuensang village. Tuensang village has its own old world charm and here one can get a glimpse of the cultural tradition of the Chang. Pay a visit to a Chang house and witness the manufacturing of the traditional handicrafts items.

Afternoon depart for Mokokchung. Mokokchung is situated at an altitude of 4347 feet, Mokokchung is the home of the Ao Naga tribe. According to the legends the Aos sprung up from "Longtrok" which means "six stones". In the past, Mokokchung was one of the preliminary locations in the Naga Hills, where the British had established their presence in the late 19th century. Later on, arrival of Christian missionaries to Mokokchung had brought a different image in the field of education and today it is having the highest literacy in the state with an average literacy rate of 84 %.

Arrive Mokokchung and drive to the beautiful modern village of Mopungchuket and check in at the small but beautiful lodge constructed and maintained by the village youth of Mopungchuket, 20 kilometers from Mokokchung, A library cum museum has been constructed and maintained by the village youth which is having a good collection of books regarding the history and the culture of the Nagas. Some efforts have been taken to construct the Morungs, (Bachelor's dormitory) carve the Time Pillar and to preserve some artifacts in the village museum.

Longkhum village: Situated at an altitude of 1846 meters Longkhum village is a forefront village with a primitive history of headhunting. The Aos believe that Longkhum is the resting place of the dead spirit onward journey to the heaven. Few people of this village still believe in the animistic religion and still worship their god "Longlanpa Tsungrem".

Overnight in Mukukchong.

DAY 27 MOKUKCHONG – WOKHA (80 km / 2 hrs) – MOKUKCHONG

Today, after breakfast proceed to Wokha. Enjoy full day sightseeing of Wokha. Return to Mokukchong. Overnight in Mokukchong.

DAY 28 MOKUKCHONG –KOHIMA (118 Kms, 7hrs drive)

Morning after breakfast depart for Kohima. Kohima is derived from the word "Kew Hi Ma" which means the men of the land where the flower Kew Hi grows. Situated at an altitude of 1444 m above sea level, Kohima is the Capital of Nagaland. Like other Naga settlement Kohima shares the same feature standing on top of the surrounding mountains. In true sense, fusion of different culture with a blend of modernism turns Kohima to a fast growing city. Arrive Kohima and check in at hotel. Later visit the Kohima War Cemetery, Kohima village,

Kohima Village is popularly known as Bara Basti (Big Village) the Kohima village is one of the largest village in Asia. Inhabited mainly by the Angami tribes it is divided into 'khels' or localities. A large traditional wooden gate welcomes you to the village which is elaborately carved with warriors and weapons and the skull of the mithun, a symbol of prosperity. Evening free at leisure. Overnight in Kohima.

DAY 29 KOHIMA

Visit the War Cemetery, The church, the Sale Emporium and local bazaar where one can be introduced to the Naga food items consisting of vegetables, insects and fishes. Overnight in Kohima.

DAY 30 KOHIMA - KHONOMA - KOHIMA 45Kms / 2½ hrs.

Today proceed on to Khonoma, the first "Green Village" of the country. Visit the Morungs, the age group house & the ceremonial gates and meet the local craftsmen. Collectively Khonoma was known for its fighting prowess in the past and for the fallow management of its alder trees which balance the nature and its surrounding areas. Enjoy picnic lunch. Afternoon indigenous games will be displayed. Return to Kohima and overnight.

DAY 31 KOHIMA – JAKHAMA VILLAGE - KOHIMA

Today visit Jakhama village experience the real Angami Naga tribal way of living. Also visit the Heritage Complex where the Hornbill festival is celebrated every year from the 1st of December to 7th of December. Overnight in Kohima Hotel.

DAY 32 KOHIMA – KAZIRANGA (230 km / 4 hrs)

Morning drive to Kaziranga. Kaziranga National Park - The World Heritage Site is the oldest park in Assam & is located on the banks of the Brahmaputra River. Kaziranga National Park is a natural habitat for conservation of biologically diverse flora & fauna. It is inhabited by the world's largest population of one-horned rhinoceroses besides sheltering about 15 species of India's threatened mammals. There are numerous other major wildlife fauna.

Enjoy Jeep Safari in the afternoon. Evening free at leisure. Overnight in Kaziranga.

DAY 33 KAZIRANGA – GUWAHATI (220 km / 4 hrs)

Early morning take an Elephant Safari at Kaziranga National Park. Return to Hotel for Breakfast,. After breakfast drive to Guwahati. Evening free for sightseeing as per available time. Overnight in Guwahati.

DAY 34 DDEPARTURE

Morning visit Maa Kamakhya Temple. In time transfer to Guwahati Airport for onward journey. Welcome on arrival in New Delhi Airport. Transfer to hotel. Overnight in New Delhi.
